

Parish Footpath Maintenance Report for July 2020

THE FOLLOWING FOOTPATHS HAVE BEEN CHECKED OR WORKED ON:

FP1. Near the SE end behind the old chicken rearing yard 33m of nettles and blackthorn have been cut and cleared.

A further 20m of nettles were cut and cleared on the section near the SE end of Harrow Lodge ground.

FP5. The steps adjacent to Plough Lane have been cleared of grass and weeds.

At the southern end adjacent to Thompson Farm land two large fallen blackthorn bushes have been cleared and cut up.

FP9. At the western end adjacent to the A134 the verge and bridge have been cleared.

Going eastward the headland between the arable land and Honey Orchard has been trimmed.

FP10. At the A134 the Finger Post has been taken away and needs a replacement. SCC Highways were advised on 06/07/2020 at 14.20 using their online reporting tool.

At the SE end adjacent to Plough Lane the verge and field bridge have been cut and cleared.

FP11. Overhanging brambles and hawthorn branches in the section from Edies Lane to the orchard have been cut and cleared.

FP12. Overhanging bramble and blackthorn have been cleared away between junction with FP21 and the open grass land.

FP16. Going SW from Fords Heath towards Spouses Vale a small bridge over a drainage dyke has been damaged and 5 pieces of decking have been broken. SCC Highways were advised 22/07/20 using their online reporting tool. A photo of the damage was included in the report.

FP18. At the northern end adjacent to Plough Lane the verge and entrance onto the golf course have been cut and cleared.

BY19. At the junction with FP12 two waymark posts had rotted at ground level. Both have been trimmed and put back in place.

FP21. Overhanging blackthorn on the western side of this path has been cut and cleared.
