

Parish Footpath Maintenance Report for September 2020

The following paths have been checked or worked on:

FP5. Checked from Plough Lane steps to the golf course fairway on 27/09/20.

The landowner has still not cut this section and the path is **completely blocked with nettles and brambles.**

BW6. Have received confirmation from SCC Highways on 08/09/20 they have asked their contractor to replace the fallen finger post at the southern end adjacent to A134. (SCC ref:287841).

FP10. Finger post at NW end is missing and was reported via SCC Highways reporting tool on 06/07/20. Checked again last week and the post has not been replaced, so sent another report on 03/10/2020 at 14.30.(SCC ref:291420).

FP11. Section from Edies Lane to the orchard ground has been cleared of overhanging brambles and shrub branches by parish volunteers.

FP12. From junction with BY19 to the open grass area, overhanging growth has been cleared away. Work done by parish volunteers.

FP13. From the junction with FP21 to the field bridge, overhanging growth has been cut back.

The visibility of the waymark post at the junction with FP14 has been improved.

Both jobs were completed by parish volunteers.

FP14. Near the SW end the section through the fruit trees has been cleared of a lot of overhanging brambles. Work completed by parish volunteers.

BY19. Fallen elm tree and two oak tree branches removed from track plus light trimming of adjacent growth from junction with FP12 south to junction with FP14. Work done by parish volunteers.

FP20. Overhanging growth cleared away from both sides of the path adjacent to the drainage ditch. Work completed by parish volunteers.

Outstanding Jobs:

FP1. Near the NW end some cutting and clearing needed from the field steps onto Stewards Barn ground.

FP3. The section over the Carrs Bridge needs some cutting back of overhanging brambles and bracken.

FP16. From Ford's Heath field bridge going NE the adjacent hawthorn hedge needs a trim before it causes an obstruction.

Please let me know if you spot any further FP problems or want clarification on any of the above points.
